

Congratulations, you have been admitted to Linnaeus University, for the autumn semester 2019.

Having chosen to study at Linnaeus University, you have also chosen a truly international study environment praised by students for its personal atmosphere, where students have close and informal relationships with teachers and other staff.

Arrival days and pick-up service

The official arrival days are 27th of August in Kalmar and 27th- 28th of August in Växjö. During the official arrival days and these days only, Linnaeus University offers a pick-up service to all international students. This means that someone will pick you up at the airport or the train station in Växjö/Kalmar when you arrive and take you to the university/accommodation as long as you have filled in our arrival form. You will receive more information about pick-up and orientation at a later stage.

Orientation Weekend for international students

To help you settle into life at Linnaeus University we will arrange Orientation days; 29th - 30th of August in Kalmar and 29th - 31st of August in Växjö. During the Orientation days you will get practical and academic information. More information will follow at a later stage. The official starting date for the autumn semester 2019 is September 2nd and ending date of the spring semester is June 7th 2020.

Admission letter

Your admission letter is your Notification of Selection Results; you can find it on your page on www.universityadmissions.se. No other document will be sent out; this is what you upload on the Migrations Agency's website when applying for the residence permit.

Tuition Fees

Students required to pay tuition fee will get a separate e-mail with more information on how to order your invoice and pay the tuition fee, please be patient, keep an eye on your e-mail account. [Here](#) you can read more about the rules regarding students that are required to pay tuition fees. You can already now prepare for your payment, the last day to pay is May 15th.

Residence Permit

If you are a citizen of a country that is not part of the EU/EES, you are most likely required to apply for a residence permit to study in Sweden. You must pay your first tuition fee instalment before the Swedish Migration Agency can grant the residence permit. You should start preparing your application for residence permit as soon as you receive this email and after the tuition fee is paid you can send in the application to the Migration Agency. Linnaeus University will notify the Swedish Migration Agency as soon as you have made the payment. You will not receive a formal letter from us that the tuition fee is paid; the information is automatically transferred to the Migration Agency. You apply online www.migrationsverket.se or at the nearest Embassy or Consulate in your home country. It is strongly recommended that you make your residence permit application online (if possible) and make sure that you include the correct documentation and pay the tuition fee before you apply. A complete application will be processed faster. Visit the Migration

Insurance

Fee-paying students are covered by the FAS insurance (the condition is that you have paid the tuition fee for the first semester). This insurance is issued under the authority of Kammarkollegiet. The insurance is backed by the full faith and credit of the Swedish government. The insurance applies 24-hours a day in the whole Schengen zone, as well as departure from your home country for direct journey to the Schengen zone up to arrival in your home country following direct journey there from the Schengen zone. Terms and conditions can be found at Kammarkollegiet's [website](#). Please note that it covers emergency medical care only. Please read through what the insurance contains and if this is not enough coverage for you, you have to purchase another insurance before you leave your home country. The insurance that we provide for you is enough for the Migration Agency. Please note that you find the information regarding your insurance on the Notification of Selection Result, this is what you upload on the Migration Agency's website when they ask you for proof of insurance.

Accommodation

You will receive a separate e-mail with more information regarding accommodation within a week. Thank you for your patience.
